Johnson Consulting and Williams Architects were recently hired by the Department of Public Works and the Purchasing Agent of the Town of Barnstable to analyze the feasibility of a new Hyannis Youth & Community Center (HY&CC) facility in the Village of Hyannis, Massachusetts. The consulting team will prepare a feasibility study, market analysis, needs assessment, and operations/business plan for the proposed facility.

With the creation of the Hyannis Youth & Community Center, the Barnstable Recreation Division of the Community Services Department, desires to improve the quality of life throughout the community by providing exceptional recreation and leisure activities at the proposed facility. The Town will demolish the existing LT Joseph P. Kennedy, Jr. Memorial Skating Rink complex and construct the proposed HY&CC facility at the same location. The new HY&CC facility will encompass 114,000 square feet and may potentially include a gymnasium, two ice skating rinks, lockers and bleacher seating for both the gymnasium and the skating rink, offices, public meeting rooms, breakout game/dance rooms, a pro shop, video arcade, computer center, and parking, among others.
